You should have received an email with your child's Snapcode and a link to access the registration portal. You will need the Snapcode in order to complete registration. Why do we do this each year?

The purpose of submitting the 2021-2022 Registration is to confirm with the school that your student will be returning next year. Based on your response, we will set up a schedule for your student and assign them to a homeroom. We will make sure online access and a Chromebook are assigned for their use. Accordingly, we will continue to observe the enhanced safety procedures and precautions that have allowed us to operate successfully this year. And while the CDC recently changed guidance that allows for 3 feet of distance between students in school, we will still be required to quarantine students and staff who are exposed to a positive case within 6 feet of distance."
